

INTERVIEW PREPARATION TIPS

WHAT TO WEAR

A good rule of thumb is that your interview clothes should be something that you have to buy on a hanger in the store.

<u>Men</u>

- Wear a tie even if you will never wear one after you get the job
- Wear clothes with a neutral color like blue, black, or grey

<u>Women</u>

- Be conservative. Don't show skin during a job interview
- If you wear a skirt, make sure it hits your knees

QUESTIONS TO ASK

- 1. Who would be my supervisor? To whom would I report?
- 2. What do you like the most about working for this company?
- 3. What are the most challenging aspects of the position?
- 4. Are there opportunities for training and professional development?
- 5. Are there opportunities for advancement within the organization? Did the previous person in my position advance within the company?
